### Four Divisions for All Abilities

Entering average for new bowlers is based on the high composite USBC book average over the past 2 years. Director may adjust up/down from there based on tournament performances or other relevant info. Handicap divisions are based on 80% of 220.

- 189 & Under Handicap:** For bowlers with averages under 190. Max hcp 46.
- 215 & Under Handicap:** For bowlers with averages from 190 to 215.
- 50+ Senior Handicap\*\*:** For bowlers aged 50 and over who average 200+. Max of 16 pins/game. Seniors averaging 220+ get 0 handicap..
- Scratch:** For bowlers averaging over 215.

### Optional Side Events • Pay On-site

#### • Progressive Pot - \$10

Increases the guaranteed 1<sup>st</sup> place prize from \$2,000 to \$2,500 and gives the champion a shot at winning 70% of the remaining pot with three more strikes across three lanes. Champion must enter the Progressive Pot in the squad he/she qualifies for the Finals. Throw 1 strike for 10% of the pot. First 2 strikes = 30%. All 3 strikes = 70%. TATurday Progressive Pot is separate from the Progressive Pot in TAT regionals. Any amount not won from the Progressive Pot carries over to the next TATurday event.

#### • Brackets - \$5 each

Handicap brackets and Senior/Scratch Division combined brackets are available. Seniors still receive their limited handicap (max 16 pins/game) in the combined Senior/Scratch brackets. Paid in cash the same day.

#### • Mystery Score - \$10

Win the entire pot up to \$500 if your second game scratch score matches the random score drawn! If no one wins on the first draw, we will continue to draw numbers for \$100 until we have a winner. There will be one winner in every squad. Any Mystery Score money remaining after the event will be carried over to the next TATurday.

### Eligibility Rules

The tournament is open to male and female bowlers meeting the below listed qualifications. For bowlers 60+ years of age, items b, c, f, g, and h do not apply.

- a. Have not held a paid membership in the PBA, PWBA, or PBA24 for at least 1 yr prior.
- b. Have not appeared on a nationally-televised PBA finals in the previous 10 years.
- c. Have never had PBA Tour 1 status nor held Exempt status in the previous 10 years.
- d. Have not won a PBA national title in the past 20 years, including the U.S. Open and USBC Masters, along with both the Senior and Women's versions of the same events.
- e. Have not competed as a National Team member in the previous 10 years or Junior National Team in the previous 5 years. Anyone under 215 average may bowl at discretion of the Tournament Director.
- f. Have not won \$5,000+ more than once in any scratch event where PBA/PWBA national champions are permitted in the last 5 years.
- g. Have not won a Regular Division title (eagle) in the USBC Open Championships in the previous 5 years in Singles, Doubles, All Events, or Team All Events.
- h. Have not won a PBA/PWBA Singles Regional title in the past 2 yrs nor Non-Champions in the past year.
- i. Employees of the hosting bowling center within 1 month prior to event are not eligible.

### Qualifying for the Finals

- Bowl 3 games across 6 lanes against the other bowlers in your division
- Cuts are 1 in 5 per division

### TATurday Finals

- Make the cut and you're guaranteed to win at least **\$200** and return to bowl in the Finals the same day.
- First round is 2 games bowled vs. up to 5 others on your pair, all in your division.
- Subsequent rounds are 1 game ea.
- If 4 or 5 bowlers are on the pair, 2 advance to the next round.
- If 2 or 3 are on the pair, 1 advances.
- If 6 are on the pair, 3 advance.
- Finals rounds repeat until only one bowler is left in each division.
- Division Champions are guaranteed at least **\$500** and bowl one game against each other to determine final placing and overall Champion.
- Hcp division champions get full 80% of 220 handicap in the Grand Final.
- **DRESS CODE** for TATurday Finals is NOT mandated as it is at regionals and nationals, but is strongly encouraged. **Grand finalists receive \$20 in TAT DSW credit when the dress code is followed throughout the Finals with attire matching national/regional TAT guidelines:** Collared shirts or jerseys. Mock collars on jerseys are allowed. Name shirts are encouraged. Slacks for men. Slacks or skirts/skorts for women. No jeans, shorts, cutoffs, cargo pants, t-shirts, hats, or headphones.
